SUBJECT: Montgomery County Police Response to ALS Incidents

In the past, the Montgomery County Police Department (MCPD) has responded routine to all MCFRS events types classified as cardiac arrest or DOA for purposes of handling an expected death.

Recently, the MCPD has updated their patrol vehicle inventory to include AEDs. MCPD patrol officers equipped with AEDs have also been trained in health-care provider CPR. Working in cooperation with the MCPD, the MCFRS ECC has created dual call types for most ECHO and some DELTA event types, classified as life-threatening (i.e., cardiac arrest, choking, ineffective breathing, etc.). These dual call types (see attached table on page 2) will create a police event type "CODE," which will trigger a routine response of the closest MCPD patrol officers equipped with AEDs. Under current MCPD policies, the officer may request that the patrol supervisor upgrade the response to Priority (i.e., emergency response) if they feel the situation warrants.

MCFRS personnel should expect to see MCPD patrol officers on the scene of these lifethreatening events; providing necessary first responder care including CPR with utilization of AEDs.
