**SUBJECT**: MAIS Forms and COG 700 Unit Numbers

With the implementation of COG 700 unit numbering the manner in which Maryland Ambulance Information System (MAIS) forms are completed must be modified.

The MAIS form *Response Identification Unit* field accepts four numeric fields. Three digit EMS units will add a 0 and enter their 3 digit unit number.



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Four digit EMS units, example A741C or M708B, the last digit, alphabetical, will be converted to a numeric value as outlined below

B = 2 D = 4 F = 6 C = 3E = 5

Example



Additional examples include:

A708B becomes 7 0 8 2 on the MAIS form A742C becomes 7 4 2 3 on the MAIS form A741F becomes 7 4 1 6 on the MAIS form

For MAIS forms completed by non EMS units the leading character remains unchanged. If a MAIS report is completed by a "Bravo" or "Charlie" suppression unit the last character of B or C is dropped. An example would be RS741B would be 3 7 4 1.
