SUBJECT: Revision of Directive 94-12, 4/22/94, Uniform Shoes

This is a revision of Directive 94-12 issued April 22, 1994. The contract between the County and the Union, in Section 45.1, Uniform Shoes, states that "employees may apply the value of the uniform shoe to alternate shoes from a mutually agreed upon list of shoes".

The approved list of uniform shoes includes:

Sears	Die Hard	Models 82102, 82402
Warrington	Pro Boots (10" only)	Models N/A
Weinbrenner	Thorogood Boot	Models LSP105, LSP016
Rocky	Eliminator	Model LSP072
Lehigh	Lockrim	Model 518
Red Wing	Firefighters Boot	Model 4475

Employees are reminded that the 10" Warrington Pro Boot and the Red Wing Firefighter Boot are **not** authorized to be worn as part of the protective envelope.

Employees are to complete the following information on the "Request for Payment Form" (Form #1010): full name, DFRS I.D. number, complete home address. The original dated receipt, which provides shoe description, must be attached to the form and forwarded directly to the Property Section. All other portions of the form are to be left blank.

The Property Section will validate the request, and process payment. Payment will be made to the employee by check mailed directly to the address of record.

Routinely, only one issued or alternate pair of shoes will be authorized every 12 month period. The replacement value of substitute footwear, either lost, stolen, destroyed, or impounded will be limited to the cost of the standard issue and secondary to any applicable insurance reimbursement.

Remove and destroy Directive 94-12, 4/22/94, and 93-26, 11/2/93, Uniform Shoes.
