Purpose:	To define level of care expectations for patients requiring albuterol	
Target Patient Population:	All patients who receive albuterol	
Guideline:	The Maryland Medical Protocols for Emergency Medical Services includes albu BLS clinicians. The intent is to provide faster treatment for acute restrictive resp distress until the arrival of ALS, not to replace ALS. There are intentionally no BLS dispatches for trouble breathing complaints. Res distress patients require ALS assessment at minimum and frequently require Altreatment. ALS to BLS downgrade decisions are governed by FCGO 20-07. Patients with I chief complaints or those who receive medications other than oxygen or oral glu not pass the ALS to BLS downgrade checklist, a situation that favors ALS transport pass the ALS to BLS downgrade for patients whose conditions require administration of albuterol because there is a likely need for further medicand continuous monitoring at the ALS level.
