SUBJECT: King LTS-D Device Training

MCFRS ALS providers currently use the Rusch Easy Tube device as a rescue airway. This device has been discontinued and is no longer available for purchase. The King LTS-D will be the replacement rescue airway device and is very similar in use to the Easy Tube.

Mandatory training on the King LTS-D Airway will be required for all Montgomery County ALS Providers and will be completed online at www.mcfrsit.com/trackingEMS. This training must be completed by June 30, 2015.

Providers should continue to use Easy Tubes that are left in stock. As the Easy Tubes are used up, the King Airway can be obtained through the normal supply procedure.
