SUMMARY: This regulation requires all volunteer applicants for Emergency

Medical Services membership in the fire and rescue corporations to pass a medical screening based on the current NFPA 1001 Medical Standards, as amended. The regulation supersedes FRC Emergency Regulation 3-93, "Volunteer Membership Categories: EMS Member

and Medical Attendant."

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BACKGROUND:

The membership category of EMS Member applies only to volunteer members of the fire and rescue corporations in Montgomery County. Applicants for this membership category must pass a medical screening consistent with the provisions of NFPA 1001 Medical Standards, as amended.

Sec. 1. **Purpose:** To require all individuals who apply for Emergency Medical Services membership in the fire and rescue corporations to pass a medical screening consistent with the provisions of NFPA 1001 Medical Standards, as amended, for their own safety as well as that of their colleagues and patients while on emergency responses.

Sec. 2. **Applicability**. This regulation applies to all volunteer fire and rescue corporations and to volunteer applicants for Emergency Medical Services membership in those corporations.

Sec. 3. **Definitions**.

- a. <u>Corporation</u>. A fire or rescue corporation established in the County authorized to provide fire, rescue, or emergency medical services.
- b. **EMS Member**. An individual who is accepted for volunteer membership by a fire and rescue corporation and is certified to perform emergency medical services only.

Sec. 4. **Policy**. All individuals who apply to become volunteer Emergency Medical Services members in the fire and rescue **corporations** must pass a medical screening consistent with the provisions of NFPA 1001 Medical Standards, as amended.



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Sec. 5. **Severability**. If a court of final appeal holds that any part of this regulation is invalid, that ruling does not affect the validity of other parts of the regulation.

Sec. 6. **Effective Date.** This regulation takes effect upon adoption of the Council resolution approving it.
