**SUBJECT: SCBA Scott AP50 Units**



MCFRS SCBA Service and Repair Facility has transitioned approximately 700 AP50 SCBA units. The support, assistance and cooperation of all MCFRS personnel in transitioning the SCBA SCOTT AP50 units is appreciated.

Personnel must do the following with the SCBA face piece, carrying bag, and the SCOTT AP50 SCBA unit.

1. All MCFRS personnel **MUST** properly label their face piece carrying bag with their Fire Service Identification (FSID #) number.
2. All MCFRS personnel **MUST** carry and use their assigned SCBA face piece at all times while on duty. Spare SCBA face pieces on apparatus should only be used on an as needed basis (emergency situations).
3. All MCFRS personnel are prohibited from altering the form, fit and design of the SCBA. This includes placing unspecified equipment on the SCBA unit, or removing specified equipment. Any changes to the form, fit or design of the SCBA unit voids the warranty and violates NFPA Standard's 1981, 1852, 1404 by placing unspecified equipment on the SCBA unit, or by removing specified equipment from the SCBA unit.
