SUBJECT: EMT-B Recertification

The Public Safety Training Academy (PSTA), in conjunction with Kaplan University, will begin offering the didactic (non-practical) component of EMT-B recertification in an on-line format. **Effective January 1, 2011, this on-line course will replace the didactic component of the twenty-four hour EMT-B recertification course currently offered at the PSTA.** The on-line didactic component consists of four hours of medical information, four hours of trauma-related information, and four hours of information determined by the local jurisdiction. ***This component must be completed not later than thirty days after being enrolled (accepted) in the course.*** The Registrar will be notified when personnel successfully complete this component.

Career personnel must complete the on-line component of EMT-B recertification during normal work hours; Station Officers must allow time for career personnel to complete this component while on-duty. Overtime is prohibited for this activity.

The practical component of EMT-B recertification will continue to be offered at the PSTA. The final session of the practical component will include a MIEMSS-provided written protocol examination. Personnel must successfully complete the didactic *and* practical components of EMT-B recertification, and successfully complete the protocol examination to be eligible for recertification as an EMT-B.
