- 4. Successfully complete a minimum of twelve hours practical driving experience on public roadways.

- 6. Successfully complete a practical test for Engine Driver/Operator, with a passing score of 70% or higher.
- 7. Successfully complete the NFPA 1002 Driving Evaluation.
- 8. Successfully demonstrate Driver/Operator skills on a minimum of ten emergency incident responses.
