

5 Things You Should Do

WHEN YOU MOVE

1. If you have your asylum application or any other application pending with USCIS, you must change your address with USCIS.
2. If you have, or are going to have, immigration court hearings, you must change your address using Form E-33.
3. If you have court hearings and have moved far away, you may also have to file a petition asking to move your court to another city.
4. If you have appointments with ICE or ASAP, you must inform your office of your address.
