Emergency Shelters

Adult Montgomery County residents can access IW shelters through referral ONLY.

Adults who are experiencing homelessness, on their own without minor children, should contact the Montgomery County Crisis Center. The Montgomery County Crisis Center is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year for those in need of emergency shelter and related resources.

The Drop-In Center hosts free and daily laundry, showers, case management, computer lab, therapeutic and recreational groups.
