Regional Manager's Report

Dianne Whitaker presented the Regional Manager's Report.

Patron use of the branch is greatest in the late morning and early afternoon. There is an uptick in patrons using branch collaboration rooms for job interviews and researching employment opportunities. There may be a near-term requirement for additional support for recently laid-off federal employees requesting assistance to locate legal and financial resources.

Collections: White Oak now meets MCPL system targets for physical book collection currency and condition. The currency target is 100% of shelved books have been circulated at least once in the past four years. This metric resulted in significant weeding of the branch's mystery collection.

Facility: There are currently no significant facility issues.

Programs: A record number of high school students attended the most recent White Oak *Teen Advisory Board* meeting.



Baby Storytime's switch to a more-frequent weekly schedule was well-received by its loyal and active participants.

Toddler Storytime is the branch's largest on-going program, averaging 65-80 attendees each week.



Saturday and Sunday Tai Chi are the branch's most popular adult programs.

The LAC is disappointed Mobile Van outreach operations were not launched during the 2024-2025 MCPL school year to complement Family Market Days hosted by Capital Area Food Bank in selected MCPS elementary schools.

The priority for the 4-member MCPL Outreach team over the next 12-18 months is mitigating the community impact of the Damascus branch closure for a refresh.
