COSPLAY CONTEST BASICS

- You do not need a library card to enter.
- Limit: one entry per person.
- Three age groups: Child (ages 0–12), Teen (ages 13–17), and Adult (ages 18+).
- Cosplay entries must be able to participate in-person at Germantown Library on **Saturday, January 14, 2023, from 3:00–4:00 PM.**
- Entry forms will only be accepted in-person at the Germantown Library on the day of MoComCon, Saturday, January 14, 2023, beginning at 1:00 PM; no electronic submissions.
- Space is limited to the first 20 entries in each age group.
- Costumes must be suitable for a family environment. No explicit content, images, words, or weapons, including replica and costume pieces.
- Contestants must adhere to all MCPL Guidelines Governing the Use of Public Libraries and Guidelines for Behavior.

COSPLAY CONTEST GUIDELINES:

- Create and dress up in a costume of your favorite character from any fandom, book, television show, movie, game (board, video, arcade or other), or invent your own original character!
- Costumes may include some purchased, pre-made components.

COSPLAY CONTEST PRIZES:

- Cosplay winners will be selected during the live MoComCon event on January 14, 2023, and must be present to participate and win.
- Prizes will be awarded in the following three categories for each age group:
 1. Best Craftsmanship
 2. Most creative
 3. Judge's Choice
- The best Sci-Fi/Fantasy costume entry in either the Teen or Adult age group will receive The Don Sakers Award.
- All judges' decisions are final.
