ESSAY CONTEST BASICS

- You do not need a library card to enter.
- Completed entries are due between **Tuesday, November 1, 2022, and Wednesday, December 14, 2022.**
- Electronic submissions only. All entries must include both essay and entry form at time of submission, and must be submitted to MCPL.MoComCon@montgomerycountymd.gov by deadline.
- The top three Essay Contest entries will be published for viewing online via the MCPL website. Essay Contest is for ages 8–14. Author’s names will not be released.
- **Deadline** for entries:
5 PM, Wednesday, December 14, 2022.

ESSAY CONTEST GUIDELINES:

- Write an essay, between 300–500 words, about the following prompt: **Who is your real-life superhero and why?**
- In this essay, you should talk about who has been a “superhero” in your real life, why you would consider them a hero, and how they have made an impact on you.
- Essays must be suitable for a family environment. No explicit content, images, words, or weapons.
- Contestants must adhere to all MCPL Guidelines Governing the Use of Public Libraries and Guidelines for Behavior.
- Essay entries must be your own original work.
- Essay Contest is for ages 8–14.
- Limit: one Essay entry per person.
- Before the deadline of **5 PM, Wednesday, December 14, 2022**, submit:
 - One Word or PDF file of the Essay
 - AND**
 - One completed electronic entry form to go with it.

ESSAY CONTEST PRIZES:

- Entries in the Essay contest will be judged on creativity, style, and appeal.
- Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners.
- Essay contest finalists and winners will be notified by email or phone prior to MoComCon.
- Essay Prizes will be available for pickup at the contestant’s selected MCPL library after January 18, 2023.
- All judges’ decisions are final.
