ADMINISTRATIVE INTERPRETATION 95-03

CODE REFERENCE: 1994 Life Safety Code (N.F.P.A. 101), Section: 20-1.1.1, 21-1.1.1, 22-1.1.1 and 23-1.1.1.

BACKGROUND: These sections apply to the application of the Life Safety Code for Lodging or Rooming Houses, One and Two - Family Dwellings and New & Existing Residential Board and Care Occupancies.

INTERPRETATION: For the purpose of the enforcement of these sections the following will apply : Any permanent living unit for five or fewer individuals with disabilities, in addition to live-in staff, shall be considered a single - family dwelling. A permanent living unit is one in which an individual intends to reside for more than thirty days. Individuals with disabilities means those persons who have a handicap as defined in the Federal Fair Housing Amendment Act of 1988. ( 42 U.S.C. s 3601 ct.seq.)
