Crews - heads up.

Today we're highlighting something simple, but critical — a tool that saves **our time** and **their lives**. It's called the **File of Life**. Some of you have seen it. Some haven't. That inconsistency? Ends today.

WHAT IS IT?

The **File of Life** is a small red magnetic packet that goes on the front of the refrigerator (or side if stainless steel) or even in a wallet. Inside the packet? **Vital medical info**:

- Name, DOB, medications, allergies
- Emergency contacts
- Preexisting conditions
- Other Key Information to help provide the best care

The File of Life packet is designed to give you **immediate access** to life-saving information when seconds count.

WHY IT MATTERS FOR US

You know the scene:

- Patient is unconscious
- Language barriers
- Family in distress
- No time to dig through drawers or hunt for pill bottles

The File of Life eliminates the guesswork. It gives us a clear medical snapshot in seconds, helping us make faster, smarter decisions. That can mean the difference between life and death.

WHY IT MATTERS FOR THE COMMUNITY

- Empowers residents, especially seniors and medically vulnerable people
- Builds community resilience they're more prepared, and we're better equipped to help
- Improves outcomes fewer delays, fewer mistakes, better continuity of care

OUR ROLE

Let's make this tool part of our routine.

- Look for it First thing when entering a residence, check the fridge for this info
- Ask about it If there's no packet, ask the patient or family
- **Educate** Carry extras on the rig, intentionally provide them during EMS or wellness checks or public events.
- Assist with completion many packets are blank. Help people FILL THEM OUT when you can.
