1.0	Valid Maryland Class "B" License or out -of-state equivalent as required.		
2.0	Candidate must be an certified heavy apparatus driver in MCFRS. (ex: engine, truck, or squad)		
3.0	Candidate will be able to properly perform an apparatus checkout, and provide adequate documentation in a checkout book.		
4.0	Candidate will successfully identify all in cab controls and gauges.		
5.0	Candidate will successfully explain safety checks and adjustment that should be made to prepare for vehicle driving.		
6.0	Candidate will identify the vehicle height, weight, length and width.		
7.0	Candidate will demonstrate proficiency in how to start the vehicle		
8.0	Candidate will properly engage and disengage the PTO.		
10.0	Candidate will demonstrate a working knowledge of the hydraulic controls both inside the cab and outside.		
11.0	Candidate will properly load and unload the Trench POD and the Local POD. Straight load and unload and rolling out from under unload.		
12.0	Candidate must complete cone course consisting of Alley dock, serpentine, parallel parking and diminishing clearance.
