- 2. Successfully complete the MCFRS Driver Training Competencies Program for Tractor Trailer Truck Driver/Operator.
- _____3. Successfully complete the written test for Truck/Tower Operator with a passing score of 70% or higher.
 - __4. Successfully complete a minimum of twelve hours practical driving experience on public roadways.
- 5. Successfully demonstrate knowledge of response area; test will be administered at the station. Trainee must obtain passing score of 70% or higher.
- 6. Successfully complete a practical test for Tractor Trailer Truck Driver/Operator with a passing score of 70% or higher.

 - 8. Successfully demonstrate Driver/Operator skills on a minimum of ten emergency incident responses in the driver's position and a minimum of ten emergency incident responses in the tiller position.
