3. Start pump. _____
4. Operate primer valve and ensure that tank to pump valve is open. _____
5. Calculate and throttle up to proper pressure. _____
6. Return to cab and activate ground sweep toggle switch. _____
7. Check ground sweep nozzles for proper flow. _____
8. Proceed in a forward direction along the simulated fireline. _____
9. Stop brush truck, apply proper braking system, turn off ground sweep toggle switch, and throttle down pump pressure. _____
10. Recognize need to refill water tank prior to returning to service. _____
