101- Fire Chief's Report

The Fire Chief reported on the status of the Coronavirus delta variant in MCFRS.

2023 MCFRS Budget – The Chief reported on the progress for MCFRS budget submission to the County Council. Commissioner Dempsey asked the Fire Chief for an update on "upstaffing of ambulances." The Chief provided an update on EMS surges.

• Commissioner Dempsey requested discussion on the Commission supporting the budget for the Public Safety Training Academy. The Chief said there have been issues with obtaining "asphalt space" to conduct classes, as well as instructors.
