SUBJECT: Need for Election Judges

As you are aware, the General Election will be held November 6, 2018. Election Judges are needed with basic IT and customer service skills for the administration of the November 6 election. Also, the Board is still in need of judges who are bi-lingual in Spanish and English, as well as those who speak other languages. To serve as an Election Judge, you must be a United States citizen, a registered voter of Maryland, and you must attend training.

I encourage you to assist the Board of Elections. Subject to supervisory approval, County employees will be granted administrative leave for each hour worked, up to a maximum of 8 hours, and qualify for an adjusted Election Judge stipend. However, employees may use annual or compensatory leave, or a personal day to qualify for the full stipend. The stipend will be paid in accordance to the Board of Election policies and the Montgomery County Ethics Law.
