RE: Need for Election Judges- 2020 Primary and General Elections

As you are aware, the Presidential Election will occur in 2020, with the Primary Election on April 28, 2020 and the General Election on November 3, 2020. Election judges with basic IT and customer service skills are needed for the administration of both elections. The Board also needs judges who are bilingual in Spanish and English, as well as those who speak other languages. To serve as an election judge, you must be a United States citizen, a registered voter in Maryland, and you must attend training.

I encourage you to assist the Board of Elections with this critical part of our democratic system. Subject to supervisory approval, County employees will be granted administrative leave for each hour worked, up to a maximum of 8 hours, and qualify for an adjusted election judge stipend. However, employees may use annual or compensatory leave, or a personal day to qualify for the full stipend. The stipend will be paid in accordance with Board of Elections policies and the Montgomery County Ethics Law.
