**Introductions** – Members and guests introduced themselves.

**Community Concerns:** Some community members have expressed concerns about water pipe repair work on Georgia Ave. including closing a lane and extending a turn signal during rush hour.

**County Police Report:**

- The Department has initiated an investigation into the White Oak video where an officer used racist language.
- The robbers who robbed a series of ATMs were recently arrested.
- Police will soon start enforcing the new speed limits on Georgia Avenue. Now a 35mph.
- There will be a community forum on June 6 to select a new police chief.

**County Fire & Rescue Report:**

- Station 25 is under renovation so trailers will temporarily replace the station
- July 1 the County’s carbon monoxide detector law goes into effect.

**County Council Report:**

- \$35 million budget proposal was cut to \$15 million.
- Budget includes a proposal to allow children under 18 to ride Metro and Ride On buses for free during all the time (and no longer just during limited hours)

**Presentation on Dog Park Sites in Mid-County:**

- The county wants 25 more new dog parks by 2030
