The Mid-County Citizens Advisory Board (MCCAB) would like to express our appreciation for your elevating the recommended priority level of the MD 97 (Georgia Avenue)/MD 28 (Norbeck Road) grade-separated interchange project, and reflecting this heightened priority in the County's letter to the State regarding recommended transportation priorities for the Maryland Department of Transportation's Consolidated Transportation Program (CTP). The Georgia Avenue/MD 28 grade-separated interchange would help to alleviate the sizeable traffic congestion caused where the mid-county's major north-south corridor intersects with its major east-west corridor.
