Fair Chance Hiring Grant	Invited employers eligible for grants when hiring Justice impacted residents	Up to \$15,000 Grant amounts \$2,500 per full- time hire.
O.J.T (On-the-Job Training)	Wage subsidies via reimbursement for training new employees within the WIOA program	Reimbursement available up to 26 weeks.

Reimbursement rates range from 50% up to 75% of the employees salary, maximum salary is \$100,000.

Paid opportunity to build skills at a worksite. Provides additional assistance to the worksite with no commitment 6-12 week experience paid through WSM at a rate of \$15/hour to clients at no cost to the business.

Free work (paid by WSM for their time) with set check-ins for skill improvement and all support to employers
