





Lamb Confit on **Brioche Rounds**

Lamb Confit

- 5 tablespoons losher salt 8 cloves gartic
- 2 shallots, peeled and roughly chopped 2 teaspoons fresh rosemary leaves
- 1 tablespoon cumin seeds, toasted and ground Coarsely ground black pepper
- 1 boneless leg of lamb About 6 cups duck and/or pork fat
- 1. Combine the first 6 ingredients in the bowl of a food processor, and process until the mixture forms a paste. Make i' deep slits in lamb leg z' apart. Slather leg with salt and herb mixture. Cover and refrigerate for 1 to 2 days.
- 2. Preheat oven to 225°F. Melt the duck and/pork fat in a medium saucepars. Wipe the excess salt mixture off the lamb. Place the meat in a high-sided baking dish or ovenproof saucepan. Pour the melted fat over the lamb (it should be covered by the fat), cover the pot with a fitted or foil, and place the pan in the over. Cook the confit at a very slow simmer-just an occasional bubble-until the lamb is fork tender. 3-4 hours. Remove the confit from the oven. Remove lamb from fat and shred. Refrigerate until ready to use. (The confit may be stored in the fat and will keep in the refrigerator for several weeks.)

Brioche Rounds 30 pieces

6 slices brioche bread



- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F. Using a 1%" round cookie cutter, cut at least four rounds out of each slice of bread. Place rounds in a single layer on sheet pan. Lightly spray both sides of the rounds with the olive oil spray.
- 2. Place pan in oven and toast the rounds for about 6 minutes on each side, flipping the rounds over halfway through. Remove the pan from the oven and let rounds cool on a
- Store rounds in air-tight container. Rounds may be made 2 days in advance. If rounds get soggy or soft, return them to a sheet pan and recrisp in a 300° oven.




