Re: Racial Equity Impact Assessment (REIA) for Supplemental Appropriation (SA) #23-104

FY23 Operating Budget of Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) Title I, Part A

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Grant

I. <u>FINDING:</u> The Office of Racial Equity and Social Justice (ORESJ) finds that Supplemental Appropriation #23-104 FY23 Operating Budget of Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) Title I, Part A Grant is acutely equipped to advance racial equity and social justice in Montgomery County as the requested funds are specifically aimed at reducing educational disparities for low-income students, which – due to historical and systemic factors – disproportionately impact young children of color. This finding is similar to ORESJ's previous analysis of Supplemental Appropriation #22-93 FY22 Operating Budget of Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) Title I, Part A Grant, which can be found <a href="https://example.com/heres/learning-new-montgoille-new-mo

II. BACKGROUND: From the MCPS Superintendent of Schools, the purpose of Supplemental Appropriation #23-104 FY23 Operating Budget of MCPS Title I, Part A Grant is to provide schools with additional support in the amount of \$2,863,919, to improve the teaching and learning for students at greatest risk of not meeting challenging academic achievement standards, especially for those who reside in areas with high concentrations of students from low-income families. The additional allocation from the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) is the result of scores calculated based on poverty and differentiation among schools, updates to selected measures, English Language Learner proficiency, and identification of Comprehensive Support and Improvement Schools and Targeted Support and Improvement Schools. There is also a grant requirement to provide

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equitable services to students and teachers in non-public schools which can include church-exempt schools and nonpublic schools that are approved by MSDE^{1,2}.

As previously mentioned, ORESJ has provided analysis on Title I, Part A in its Racial Equity Impact Statement (REIA) of <u>Supplemental Appropriation #22-93 FY22 Operating Budget of Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) Title I, Part A Grant</u>. This REIA specifically documents inequities in educational opportunity and resources impacting the experiences of students identified as Black, Indigenous, or People of Color (BIPOC) – particularly those that are low-income – in Montgomery County.
