

Police Accountability Board of Montgomery County, MD
April 2023 Complaint Report

Complaints entered into the Portal: 1

- 1 was defined as Ineligible, due to the incident involving a member of Law Enforcement currently under a collective bargaining agreement and therefore must go through the previously established Internal Affairs review.

Complaints received through other methods*: 2

- 1 was defined as Ineligible, due to the incident involving a member of Law Enforcement currently under a collective bargaining agreement and therefore must go through the previously established Internal Affairs review.
- 1 was defined as “State ACC jurisdiction”
 - Maryland National Capital Park Police reported they received 1 complaint that is eligible under PAB legislation, but complaints received for MNCPP are within State ACC jurisdiction so no additional information can be reviewed at a local level.

*Other methods are defined as:

- PAB Staff
 - By Phone to the Office of the County Executive or PAB staff
 - By Email to the County Executive or other local, state governing agencies
 - In Person or Hand Delivered to the Office of the County Executive or PAB Staff
 - Mailed to the Office of the County Executive or PAB staff
- Law Enforcement Agency
 - By Phone to Agency
 - By Email to Agency
 - In Person to Agency
 - Mailed to the Agency
 - Online to Agency (outside of the PAB Complaint Portal)
 - Other Method previously established by Agency

*What makes a complaint Eligible:

- The incident must have occurred after 7/1/22, the Establishment of the legislation
- The incident must involve a member of the public and actions of a member of Law Enforcement
- The incident must involve a member of Law Enforcement not currently under a collective bargaining agreement. Those under collective bargaining agreements still fall under Law Enforcement Officers Bill of Rights until 7/1/2023
- Each month, Montgomery Country Law Enforcement Agencies* report to the PAB (through PAB Staff) any complaints they received (through the portal or other methods) and the status of the investigation, for any eligible complaints

*Montgomery County Law Enforcement Agencies include:

- Montgomery County Police Dept.
- Montgomery County Sheriff’s Office
- Chevy Chase Village Police Dept.
- City of Gaithersburg Police Dept.
- City of Rockville Police Dept.
- City of Takoma Park Police Dept.
- Montgomery County Fire Explosive Investigators
- Maryland National Capital Park Police – Montgomery County Division* (*State ACC jurisdiction)

Note: There was an error in the March 2023 Complaint Report as it related to why it was Ineligible.

Complaints entered into the Portal: 1

- 1 was defined as Ineligible, due to ~~the incident occurring prior to 7/1/2022~~ **the incident involving a member of Law Enforcement currently under a collective bargaining agreement** and therefore must go through the previously established Internal Affairs review.
