1. Call to Order

6. New Business

Ad-hoc Committees:

Listening Tour – Discussed meeting with Silver Spring Justice Coalition, Impact, and PARC feedback and timeline for the final report (within 6 weeks). The following areas were shared to help with improvements and raise awareness.

- Complaints access and conversion to other language
 - Have the Complaint forms be available in other languages besides English and Spanish
 - Have the Language formats be representative of the various populations in the county and communities.
- Placing complaint forms in different organization
 - Making complaint forms available in various community organizations throughout the county.
 - Churches, Synagogues, Recreations Centers, Mosques etc.
- Set up a phone line with a phone tree for multiple languages.
 - Have the Complaint Phone Line function in such a manner that when an individual calls in and English is their second language there are other languages available to them to get information/instructions to file a complaint.

Body Worn Camera (BWC) – Provided updates on work progress with the PAB staff and analysis done. The Elkton Police Department and Montgomery County Law Enforcement agencies have been provided with questions for feedback. The final report will be finalized upon receipt of feedback.
