- In September, the Commission had a speaker from the County Planning Department discuss the accessibility of streetscapes, sidewalks and crosswalks. A discussion on establishing Priorities/Goals for the upcoming year was held. Priorities discussed included affordable and accessible housing, transportation, personal care attendant services and the caregiver crisis, disability awareness, courts accessibility, employment, emergency management preparedness and preschool early intervention.
