

The manual contains the latest appropriate standards as established and approved by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies. Compliance with all procedures in the manual assures the employees, and the public they serve, that the best professional standards in law enforcement are being observed.

It is the duty of every employee of this office to be completely familiar with the contents of the manual and abide by it in the performance of their duties.
