- Strongest representation from Silver Spring (inside and outside beltway), Bethesda, Wheaton
- Strongest support for creating connections to places (e.g. Neighborhood Greenways)
- Followed by support for outdoor restaurant seating & places to recreate / socialize






## A Three-Pronged Approach

- Shared Streets Block Permit



























