Survey Response

- Opened May 29, will close June 30
- >800 resident responses
- >20 business responses
- <1% total responses in Spanish



Preliminary Findings

- Strongest **representation** from Silver Spring (inside and outside beltway), Bethesda, Wheaton
- Strongest support for **creating connections** to places (e.g. Neighborhood Greenways)
- Followed by support for **outdoor restaurant seating & places to recreate / socialize**
