MCPD Situational Update

- Update on holiday season MCPD community outreach events in Urban District.

- Holiday traffic task force is active, focusing on DWI and other dangerous traffic concerns.

Silver Spring PLD Update (Thommana)

- Overview of PLD, sources of revenue (mainly fees and fines).
- Major capital needs.
 - Elevators largest.
 - Dire need to increase spending.
- Labor and materials experiencing cost increases as well as inflationary pressures.
- Utilization moving closer to pre-pandemic levels.
- Length of stay has dropped.
- Future revenue projections and possible operational changes to increase funds.
