



Chapter 22A. Forest Conservation - Trees.

Article I. General.

Sec. 22A-1. Short title.

This Chapter may be referred to as the Montgomery County Forest Conservation Law. (1992 L.M.C., ch. 4, § 1)


(g) In lieu fee.

(1) General. If a person satisfactorily demonstrates that the requirements for reforestation or afforestation on-site or off-site cannot be reasonably accomplished, the person must contribute money to the forest conservation fund at a rate specified by law or Council

Council finds that tree loss as a result of development and other land disturbing activities is a serious problem in the County.

- (b) *Purpose*. The purpose of this Chapter is to:
- (1) save, maintain, and plant trees and forested areas for the benefit of County residents and future generations;
- (2) establish procedures, standards, and requirements to minimize tree loss as a result of development and to protect trees and forests during and after construction or other land disturbing activities;

























