- II. Approval of 3 letters:
  - a. Clarksburg Library Motion to approve by Andrew Saundry with 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jay Guan.
  - b. Observation Drive Motion to approve by Jay Guan and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Andrew Saundry.
  - c. Goshen Road Approved with the letter addressed to County Executive and Council Members and change of the word "of" in the last sentence to "for". Motion to approved by Andrew Saundry and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Paul Klee.
- III. Update from MCPD (Commanders Liz Hattenburg, Lt Cody Fields, Lt Kristina Hedgepeth):
  - a. Commander Hattenburg 5 residential burglaries in the Rockville area in the last 30 days.
  - b. Lt Fields auto thefts up, mostly from unlocked vehicles. Officers have made major arrests from minor traffic stops which led to drugs and weapon seizures.
  - c. Lt Hedgepeth Homicide on February 16<sup>th</sup> with arrest made the following day. Placing security cameras for crime areas like Cider Mill will follow up in 6 weeks.
- IV. Update from the County Council: Representatives from Luedtke, Albornoz, Glass, Balcombe, and Katz.
  - a. Glass office economic development roadmap, safe streets act next week, public hearings for CE budget.
  - b. Luedtke office Shady Grove advisory re: bus depot.
  - c. Katz office opioids, safety, and planning board review.
  - d. Albernoz office lunch meeting with RSC directors. Wellness service project update.
  - e. Balcombe office working on Observation drive and Clarksburg Library. P3 projects update and Mark Station.
- V. Public School Safety Forum (Mr. Ed Clarke Director of School Safety, and Mr. Bakari Haynes Vice Principal Clarksburg High School)
  - a. Refocus expectations about school safety again at beginning of second semester.
  - b. No bathroom door issues at Clarksburg, do bathroom checks.
  - c. 2 security assistants per middle school and 6 assistants per high school.
  - d. Added 12 elementary school rovers.
  - e. Increase in hate bias incidents. Staff retrained to identify bias.
  - f. More restroom checks (substance use).
  - g. Increase in fentanyl use (non-fatal).
    - i. Training on use of Narcan
    - ii. Forum at Clarksburg High School was well attended.
    - iii. Discussed how Montgomery County can provide treatment support.
