

Responsibility is shared




Safety is proactive



Redundancy is crucial





Advancing Bikeway Projects in North Bethesda


Most recent project along Marinelli Road at the Metro Station.

- White Flint West Workaround completed in 2022.
- Old Georgetown Road bikeway completed in April 2023.
- Marinelli Road Separated Bike Lane –
 Phase 1 completion this summer.
- Rockville Pike Sidewalk and Shared Use Path from Strathmore Avenue to Pooks Hill Road – construction starting soon.




Over 70 new installations since Vision Zero started

NEW SIGNAL AND BEACON INSTALLATIONS




5 Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon and 2 Traffic Signals scheduled for installation.

Inaugural Summertime Alcohol Task Force

Promoting Safe Rides Home

- 127 impaired driving arrests with 1,164 citations, 1,249 warnings, and 84 equipment repair orders in nine weeks.
- Outreach to bars and restaurants by Alcohol Beverage Service with inspections and safety materials.
- Promote <u>Safe Ride Home page</u> to provide one stop shop for finding sober ride options in Montgomery County.


More sites and new technology

Recent Expansions and Changes

- Graduated fines for speed camera violations start October 1.
- The County and S.H.A. are studying speed cameras on High Injury Network with new authority granted by Maryland General Assembly.
- Start using red-light cameras as speed cameras where allowed.
- Permitted to use bus lane cameras. Pilot started with WMATA.
- 44 new speed locations approved in August 2024.

Needing State Law changes

 Using new technology for enforcing seatbelts, mobile phone use, crosswalks, move over law, HOV.





Examples of mobile phone use captured by distracted driving cameras. At 3 pilot sites, over 780 violations detected in 3 days.





Finding latest crash and fatality data


County and State Resources

Highway Safety Office Fatal Crash

Dashboard. Fatal crashes typically added within 24-48 hours.

County Monthly Crash Summary. Updated middle of each month for crashes through the prior month.

<u>Crash open data</u>. Raw version of crash data updated weekly.
