Directions to the Executive Office Building Auditorium

Transit Instructions:

The Montgomery County Executive Office Building is served by the Rockville station on Metro's red line and over a dozen bus routes. To find the transit route most convenient for you, use Metro's trip planner or a third-party map service such as Google Maps or Bing Maps.

From the Rockville metro station:

- 1. Take the pedestrian bridge over Rockville Pike.
- 2. At Monroe St, take a left and walk one block to the Executive Office Building.
- 3. Note that the entrance located at the circle is **not** available after 6PM. Continue walking along Monroe St until you see the Terrace Level entrance.
- 4. We will have someone at the door to guide you to the auditorium, but in case there is no one available please use the intercom located to the left of the entrance to contact security and let them know you are here for the Vision Zero Equity Task Force.
- 5. Walk straight through the cafeteria seating and walk up the stairs or use the elevators to go to level "L." At the top of the staircase, the entrance to the auditorium is to the left and behind the main staircase. From the elevators, walk into the lobby and enter the auditorium to the right of the staircase.


Parking Information & Directions:

The Montgomery County Executive Office Building located at 101 Monroe St, Rockville, MD 20850. Free parking is available in the Council Garage after 6PM and is accessible from <u>East</u> <u>Jefferson St and Monroe St</u>.

From the Council Garage:

- 1. Walk north and cross East Jefferson St to the Executive Office Building (the tallest tan building on this block)
- 2. Enter the EOB through the Terrace Level entrance. This entrance is the only entrance available for after-hours meetings.
- 3. We will have someone at the door to guide you to the auditorium, but in case there is no one available please use the intercom located to the left of the entrance to contact security and let them know you are here for the Vision Zero Equity Task Force.
- 4. Walk straight through the cafeteria seating and walk up the stairs or use the elevators to go to level "L." At the top of the staircase, the entrance to the auditorium is to the left and behind the main staircase. From the elevators, walk into the lobby and enter the auditorium to the right of the staircase.
