



Bee Balm

(*Monarda didyma*)

- Ht 4 ft x W 3 ft
- Moist to wet soils
- Attracts butterflies, bees and hummingbirds



New England Aster

(*Aster novae-angliae*)

- Ht 4–6 ft x W 2–3 ft
- Average to moist soil
- Attracts Monarch and other butterflies in fall



Black-Eyed Susan

(*Rudbeckia hirta* or *Rudbeckia fulgida*)

- Ht 1–3.5 ft x W 2 ft
- Average to dry soil
- Seeds attract birds in fall and winter.
- Evergreen rosette



Bluestar

(*Amsonia tabernaemontana*)

- Ht 2 ft x W 3 ft
- Dry to moist soil
- Leaves turn yellow in fall



Butterfly Milkweed

(*Asclepias tuberosa*)

- Ht 1–3 ft x W 1–3 ft
- Dry to average soil
- Attracts Monarch and other butterflies



Blazing Star

(*Liatris spicata*)

- Ht 3–5 ft x W 2 ft
- Average to moist soil
- Attracts butterflies and bees





Little Bluestem

(Schizachyrium scoparium)

- Ht 3–4 ft x W 1.5 ft
- Average to dry soil
- Bronze-orange fall color



Moss Phlox

(Phlox subulata)

- Ht 6 in x W 1–3 ft
- Average to dry soil
- Evergreen groundcover, great for slopes



Purple Coneflower

(Echinacea purpurea)

- Ht 2–3 ft x W 2 ft
- Average to dry soil
- Seeds attract goldfinches in fall and winter



Sea Oats

(Chasmanthium latifolium)

- Ht 2–3 ft x W 2–3 ft
- Average to moist soil
- Spreads quickly, good erosion control



Switchgrass

(Panicum virgatum 'Shenandoah')

- Ht 3–5 ft x W 2–3 ft
- Dry, average and moist soil
- Good erosion control



False Blue Indigo

(Baptisia australis)

- Ht 3 ft x W 3 ft
- Dry, average and moist soil
- Interesting seed pods
