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## Construction Activities Anticipated Beginning January 2, 2022

### Executive Boulevard at Old Georgetown Road (MD 187) New Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) for Vehicles and Pedestrians

As a reminder to the traveling public and County residents, the newly configured intersection of Executive Boulevard at Old Georgetown Road is open to both vehicular and non-vehicular traffic. The intersection is reopened and traffic patterns have returned to the preconstruction state with lane shifts. Please follow pavement markings and signage and exercise caution through the work zone.

In addition, please pay attention to the current traffic shift started earlier in December on Executive Boulevard between the Old Georgetown Road intersection and the signalized intersection for 6000/6001 Executive Boulevard. Each direction has only a single lane in this area. Please drive with caution through this stretch of roadway.

### Accomplishments Last Period

At the end of November, Corman Kokosing Construction Company's (Corman) paving subcontractor completed a hot mix asphalt (HMA) overlay of the east and westbound lanes of Old Georgetown Road between the Grand Park Avenue and Executive Boulevard intersections. Because of the numerous surface depressions, potholes, and other hazards, the Contractor overlaid the area to improve safety and ride ability.

Between 11/01/2021 and 12/31/2021, Corman and their subcontractors completed the following major activities:

- Installed the new WSSC ten (10) inch ductile iron pipe (DIP) water line on the west side of Towne Road;
- Placed over 300 linear feet of new 36" storm drain line as well as five (5) new storm drain manholes for the new system on the west side of Towne Road;
- Poured 2,826 square feet of new five (5) inch sidewalk which included completion of the eight (8) foot wide walkway that runs along the south side of Executive Boulevard and the east side of Old Georgetown Road from the signal for 6000 Executive Boulevard to the tie-in point on Old Georgetown Road directly across from the MNCPPC Aquatic Center/Park back entrance;
- Completed turf grass establishment using sod and permanent seed in the new green areas along Executive Boulevard and Old Georgetown Road;

- Partially built the new westbound lanes of Executive Boulevard and southbound lanes of Old Georgetown Road.



### **Building the Lanes of Executive Boulevard and Old Georgetown Road**

#### **Upcoming Construction Activities**

Corman and their subcontractors will continue with work on Old Georgetown Road, Executive Boulevard, Banneker Avenue between Old Georgetown Road and the T-Mobile building's back entrance, and Towne Road. During the upcoming period, the contractor will perform the following major activities:

- On Towne Road between the cul-de-sac and Rose Avenue, Corman's subcontractor will continue installing new 18" WSSC sanitary sewer line and a series of manholes;"
- On Towne Road, one Corman pipe crew will keep installing new 36" storm drain line and their included manholes as a second Corman pipe crew installs the lateral lines and structures connected to the new 36" drain system;
- Corman's general construction crew will continue building the new intersection for Executive Boulevard, Towne Road, and Old Georgetown Road;
- Corman's grading crew will proceed with building the new limits for the southern stretch of Towne Road as well as the new westbound lanes of Old Georgetown Road between Grand Park Avenue and Executive Boulevard.

In addition, in different areas of the project, Corman's subcontractors will carry on with their work installing telecommunication and signalization conduits.

Parking is still not permitted on either side of Towne Road, or in the cul-de-sac. Violators will be subject to citations; violators impeding the construction will be towed. All construction and utility crews are currently working daytime hours. Except for the upcoming water main line service interruptions on December 27, 2021, and January 3, 2022, all crews will continue to work standard work hours, from 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

In these active work zones, especially on Towne Road, be sure to look for the orange warning signs, cones, arrow panels, and flaggers, as well as trucks and digging equipment entering and exiting the work areas. Please pay attention to any temporary road closure(s), look for steel roadway plates, expect driving delays, and look for possible pedestrian detours as

multiple contractors conduct these ongoing field operations. For safety, MCDOT and Corman maintains portable speed display indicators to caution traffic and keep speeds down on northbound and westbound Old Georgetown Road.
